Release of Video Footage from February 8 Fatal Pedestrian Crash in Baltimore City Delayed

BALTIMORE, MD (February 24, 2023) – In order to carry out an appropriately thorough investigation, the Independent Investigations Division (IID) is delaying the release of video footage in the fatal pedestrian crash following an attempted traffic stop in East Baltimore on February 8.

Once the investigation permits, the IID will make public the camera footage on its [video channel](#).

Per the IID protocols, “The IID will generally release body camera footage within 14 days of the incident. There may be situations where more than 14 days is necessary, including if investigators need more time to complete witness interviews, if there are technical delays caused by the need to redact the identities of civilian witnesses, or to allow family members to view the video before it is released to the public.”
