Body-Worn Camera Footage from Fatal Police Pursuit in Baltimore Released

BALTIMORE, MD (April 13, 2023) – The Independent Investigations Division (IID) of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General today released the [body-worn camera footage](#) from the fatal police pursuit that occurred on March 25 in Baltimore City. The decedent was previously identified as 74-year-old Linda Moss of Westminster, Maryland.

Maryland law mandates the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) investigate all police-involved fatalities in the State of Maryland beginning October 1, 2021. These investigations are conducted by the office's Independent Investigations Division, in conjunction with the Maryland State Police. The OAG and Baltimore Police have reached an agreement to allow for the Attorney General's investigation while still allowing Baltimore Police to meet the investigatory obligations of its federal consent decree.
