Attorney General Brown Releases Statement on Verdict in Neil Adleberg Trial

BALTIMORE, MD (June 30, 2023) –Maryland Attorney General Anthony G. Brown issued the following statement on today’s verdict in the Neil Adleberg trial:

“Today, Neil Adleberg was acquitted of all charges. The outcome of the trial does not diminish the courage of the survivor in this case. It takes remarkable strength to break the silence and confront pain and trauma of the past.

“To the survivor, your voice matters, your story deserved to be heard no matter the outcome of this trial. We continue to stand with you; we believe you. The path to justice may be arduous, and today’s acquittal does not define the validity of your experience.

“As we continue to investigate sexual abuse associated with the Archdiocese of Baltimore, the Archdiocese of Washington D.C., and the Diocese of Wilmington, DE, we ask anyone who has suffered silently to come forward. Our priority, now and always, is to stand with the victims and survivors of these heinous acts. No one should bear the weight of such pain alone. My office is dedicated to investigating these crimes and pursuing justice. We will continue to advocate for the rights and well-being of survivors, and to provide the support and resources needed to heal and rebuild their lives.”
