Body-Worn Camera Footage from In-Custody Death in Baltimore City Released

BALTIMORE, MD (August 29, 2023) – The Independent Investigations Division (IID) of the Office of the Attorney General today released the [body-worn camera footage](#) from the in-custody death that occurred on July 25, 2023, in Baltimore City. The decedent was previously identified as 29-year-old Trea Ellinger of Glen Burnie, Maryland.

The IID will generally release body-worn camera and dashboard camera footage within 14 days of an incident. The release of the body-worn camera footage in this incident was delayed while investigators determined the involved officers and conducted witness interviews, as well as the video editing process.
