Body-Worn and Dashboard Camera Footage Release Delayed in December's Fatal Pursuit in Montgomery County

BALTIMORE, MD (January 12, 2024) – The Independent Investigations Division (IID) of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General today announced the delay of the release of the bodyworn and dashboard camera footage of the fatal police pursuit in Montgomery County on December 13, 2023.

The delay in the release of the footage is the result of investigators needing additional time to review video footage and to allow investigators to conduct witness interviews.

Per the IID protocols, "The IID will generally release body camera footage within 20 business days of the incident. There may be situations where more than 20 business days are necessary, including if investigators need more time to complete witness interviews, if there are technical delays caused by the need to redact the identities of civilian witnesses, or to allow family members to view the video before it is released to the public."
