Body-Worn Camera Footage from Baltimore County Police Fatal Officer-Involved Shooting in January Released

BALTIMORE, MD (March 15, 2024) – The Independent Investigations Division (IID) of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General today released the [body-worn camera footage](#) from the Baltimore County Police Department’s fatal officer-involved shooting that occurred on January 9, 2024, in Pikesville, Maryland. The decedent was previously identified as 29-year-old Sha-Kim Akil Webley of Windsor Mill, Maryland.

The IID will generally release body-worn camera and dashboard camera footage within 20 business days of an incident. The release of body-worn camera footage in this incident was delayed to allow additional time for the IID to redact information that raises safety concerns and to allow the involved parties to view the video before its release.
