Officers Identified and Unredacted Body-Worn Camera Footage Released in January's Baltimore County Police Fatal Officer-Involved Shooting

BALTIMORE, MD (March 29, 2024) - The Independent Investigations Division (IID) of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General has identified the Baltimore County Police Department officers involved in the fatal officer-involved shooting on January 9, 2024, in Pikesville, Maryland. The decedent was previously identified as 29-year-old Sha-Kim Akil Webley of Windsor Mill, Maryland.

The Baltimore County police officers are identified as Officer Helphenstine, a 5-year veteran; Officer Taylor, a 4-year veteran; and Officer Fleck, a 3-year veteran. All of the officers are assigned to the Operations Bureau.

On March 15, 2024, the IID released a redacted version of the body-worn camera footage shielding the officers' names and faces due to safety concerns. An updated release of the body-worn camera footage without these redactions can be found here.
