Body-Worn Camera Footage from Fatal Police Pursuit in Baltimore County Released

BALTIMORE, MD (May 9, 2024) – The Independent Investigations Division (IID) of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General today released the [body-worn camera footage](#) from the fatal police pursuit that occurred on April 8, 2024, in Windsor Mill, in Baltimore County. The decedent was previously identified as 37-year-old Dimeka Thornton of Windsor Mill, Maryland.

The IID will generally release body-worn camera and dashboard camera footage within 20 business days of an incident. The release of body-worn camera footage in this incident was delayed to allow the decedent's family and subject officers to view the video before it was released to the public.
