## Decedent and Officers Identified in In-Custody Death Investigation in Baltimore County

**BALTIMORE, MD (January 16, 2024)** – The Independent Investigations Division of the Office of the Attorney General has identified the decedent and involved officers in the in-custody death that occurred on January 10, 2024, in Owings Mills.

The decedent has been identified as 41-year-old Craig Cousin of Pikesville, Maryland.

The Baltimore County Police officers have been identified as Officer Cantrell, a 4-year veteran; Officer Folderauer, a 5-year veteran; Officer Eskins, a 12-year veteran; and Officer Marsh, who has a total of 7 years of law enforcement experience. All of the officers are assigned to the Operations Bureau.
