Deputy and Decedent Identified in Fatal Collision in Carroll County

BALTIMORE, MD (April 23, 2024) – The Independent Investigations Division of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General has identified the involved deputy and decedent in the fatal crash that occurred on April 20, 2024, in Eldersburg, in Carroll County, Maryland.

The decedent has been identified as 22-year-old Kayla Rodriguez-Garcia of Randallstown, Maryland.

The Carroll County Sheriff's Deputy has been identified as Deputy First Class Kyle Hesler. Deputy Hesler has been with the Carroll County Sheriff's Office since September 2023 and has a total of four years of law enforcement experience. Deputy Hesler is assigned to the Operations Division.
