Mr. Karberg:

On March 1, 2022, the Maryland Department of Health (MDH) received notification that documents containing sensitive information were posted to our public website. We took action to remove the documents from our website and began an investigation into the matter. MDH determined that the names and social security numbers of twenty three (23) individuals and one (1) individual's name and medical record account number were exposed in this incident.

While the investigation of this matter is continuing, MDH has prepared individual notice letters to the individuals affected. MDH intends to mail these letters no later than May 2, 2022.
