RE: Breach Notification

Dear Attorney General Brown:

Please be advised that we represent the Town of North Kingstown, Rhode Island (“the Town”) in regard to a recent cyber security incident. Pursuant to M.D. COML § 14-3504, we are reporting to you, on behalf of the Town, that the Town will notify 71 Maryland residents of a breach of their personal information.

On April 22, 2023, the Town detected unusual activity on its internal network, and it promptly took steps to mitigate the incident. The Town consulted with third-party cybersecurity experts to assist with its response to the incident and notified law enforcement. On July 7, 2023, the Town determined that personal information may have been affected by this incident. The type of information affected included name, address, Social Security number and/or driver’s license number.

The Maryland residents affected by this incident will receive notice on or about July 24, 2023. We will provide a copy of the notices under separate cover. North Kingstown is offering credit monitoring at no charge for a period of 24 months to affected individuals.
